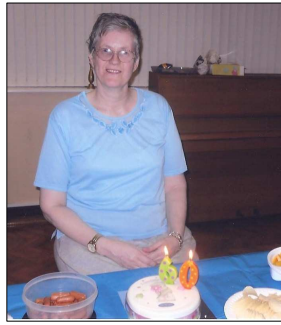


Birthday Celebration!
